Who Is The Holy Spirit?

Introduction: The Holy Spirit is often mentioned in the Scriptures, but still a mystery to many. This may be due, in part, to the unknown things about Him that we are not told (Deuteronomy 29:29); the prejudices surrounding the translation of the word "Ghost"; the absence of Him having a personal name; the lack of many recorded conversations by Him; or the many false notions and doctrines that are in the religious world today. There is only one Spirit - Eph 4:4; but, who is He?
