

From the Christians who are the Appleton church of Christ: Thank you for visiting us today.

We hope we all get a chance to say hello. This letter is not intended to take the place of a personal greeting. But, there are some things we'd like you to know about us that cannot be said in the few minutes we have to be with you.

When you read the New Testament of the Bible, you will find recorded many of the activities of the early church of Jesus Christ. We believe that churches of our day ought to try to be as much like that early church as possible, because the policies of that Christian community were decided by the Apostles of Jesus, who in turn were guided directly by the Holy Spirit of God. We come closest to being the kind of people who gained

God's approval in the early days of the church's existence when we imitate the work, worship and living of the early Christians.

This approach to Christianity does not mean we try to turn back the clock 2,000 years. It does not mean we travel on donkeys or wear sandals! It does mean that as a church we try to avoid the "improvements" people have tried to make over the centuries, for they were not guided in the way the apostles were. We hope that we have made the nature, organization, work and worship of this church the same as that of the original church of Christ.

There may be some aspects of our service you found unusual or strange. We hope we have not made you uncomfortable; that is certainly not our intent. But, we do

have reasons for conducting our activities in particular ways. If you wonder, please ask! We would be glad to spend some time explaining to you, from the Bible, the reasons for our approach to serving God. If a person-to-person study interests you, let us know. 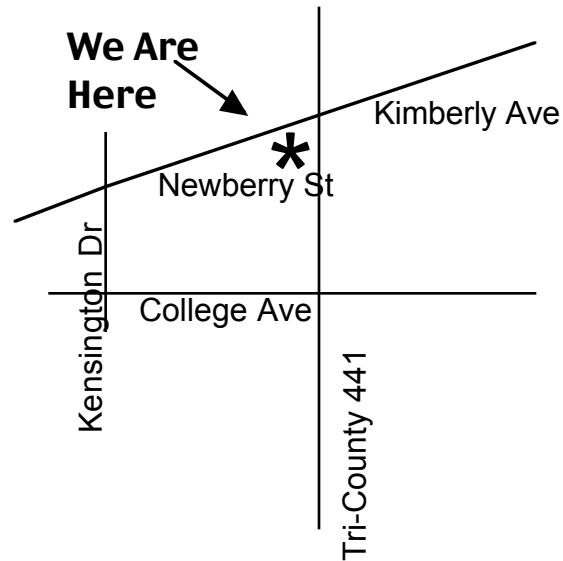
